Terms and Conditions of Adoption

- The Adopter, must be over 18 years of age and have never been convicted of any animal cruelty offence, nor have any current proceedings pending.
- The Adopter agrees to:
 - not sell, abandon or rehome the animal but to contact K9focus for advice and help on finding a new home.
 - take care of the Animal and to make adequate provision for its welfare
 - obtain qualified veterinary treatment for the Animal if it becomes ill or is injured.
 - take all reasonable steps to find the Animal should it go missing and notify the local police and authorities
 - not euthanise the animal without prior agreement from K9focus unless in an emergency on medical grounds
 - permit an authorised representative of K9focus to visit their premises from time to time to be assured that the Animal is happily settled
 - allow K9focus to repossess the Animal if in their opinion the terms of this agreement are not being reasonably adhered to
 - exercise the Animal regularly and not to chain or tether the Animal or leave it without companionship for extended periods
 - abide by all legal requirements relating to dogs
 - ensure their name and address is permanently inscribed on a collar worn by the Animal or on a plate/badge attached to it
 - not breed from the animal
 - where applicable arrange for the Animal to be neutered/spayed as soon as possible – usually within a period of 2 months from adoption
 - Make a non-refundable donation which will be agreed at the time of adoption.
- The Adopter understands that:
 - K9focus accepts no responsibility as to description, condition or health of the Animal and gives no warranty of any kind expressed or implied
 - while K9focus will pass on as much information as possible regarding the behaviour, habits and past history of the animal, they do not always have the full history of the dog and therefore are unable to offer any guarantees or warranties regarding behaviour or temperament.
 - the Animal is believed to be in normal health except where specific conditions have been made known to the Adopter in writing. It is regretted that K9focus is unable to accept liability for any expenses of any kind arising from sickness developed subsequently.
 - in cases where an animal is known to possess a specific condition, the presence of which is notified to the Adopter, the responsibility for and cost of future treatment shall be borne by the Adopter.
 - the rescue strongly advises all adopters to arrange appropriate third party liability and pet insurance.
 - the donation in respect of the animal is not for the purchase of the animal but goes towards the rescue of present and future animals and is not refundable under any circumstances.
 - Our adoption fees vary between £150 and £195 depending on age, breed and temperament. The adoption fee will be advised before adoption and will include vaccination, microchip and neutering.
 - In adopting and taking possession of the dog they assume all legal responsibility for any loss or damage caused by the dog to either themselves or a third party.

Please note that K9focus does not support the use of Choke Chains, Spike Chains or Electric Collars and will not rehome where there is evidence that these will be used. We are happy to give advice on other methods of controlling dogs that pull on a lead
